He has worked within globally accepted frameworks, such as the Responsible Business Alliance (RBA), Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD), etc.

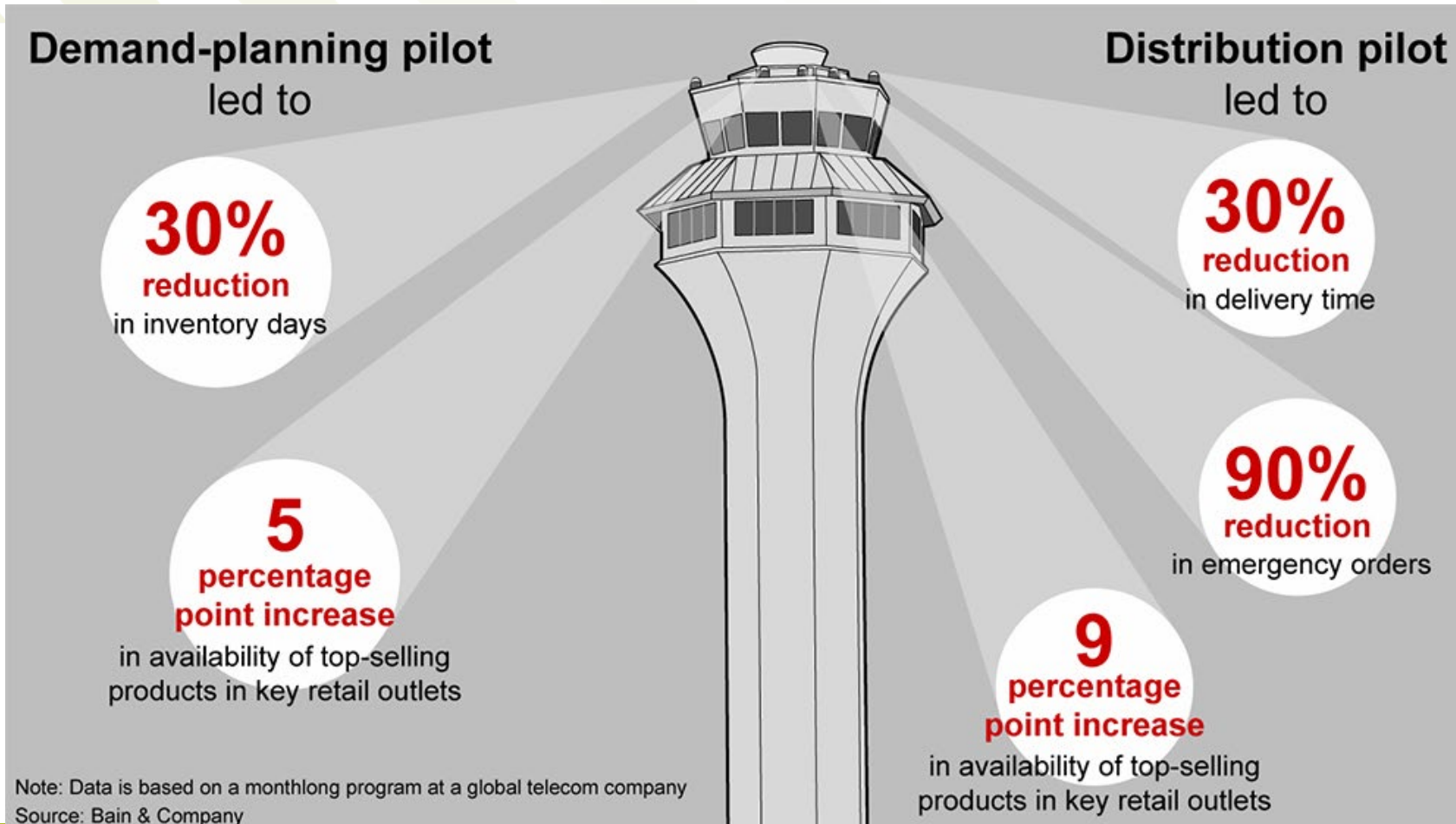
Ed has led teams in Argentina, Australia, Brazil, China, Europe, and India.

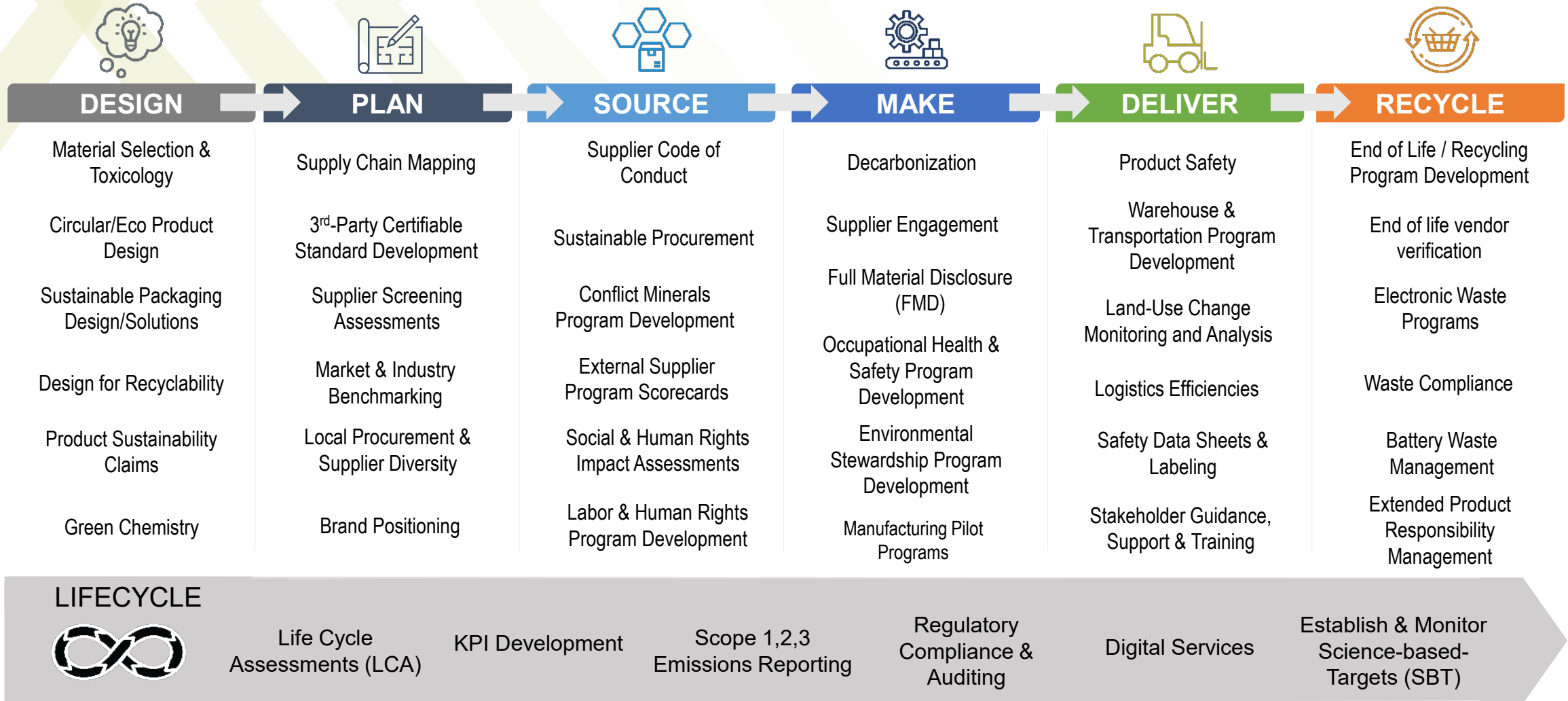
