What does the ISO 9001 standard cover?

This standard shows the ability for organisations to consistently provide products and services that meet customer and regulatory requirements. ISO 9001 covers the documenting and reviewing of structures, responsibilities and procedures required to achieve effective quality management.

Topics covered include:

- Requirements for a QMS, including documented information, planning and determining process interactions
- Management of resources, including human resources and the work environment
- Product realisation, including steps from design through to delivery
- Responsibilities of management
- Measurement, analysis and improvement of the QMS
